Titan's Contract repository feature supports the contract management process.

- Contractual documents are securely stored for long periods of time. Such information may – or may not – be used again in the future, but nonetheless should be stored until the end of its retention schedule based on the defined Standards in companies records management, as well as relevant local law requirements. All electronically archived executed contracts shall be stored as executed versions only.
- Archiving is vitally important for information management and can give a businesses greater control over their information processes. Furthermore, we have integrated contracts from companies into our Discovery feature in order to make sure that users can find information in an optimized way.

In the long run, our intention was to further develop automated text recognition and automatic character recognition within images (for example, in our contract PDFs, but also every information from company presentations and success stories that are stored on Titan SIM). Originally, automatic text recognition was based on optical character recognition (OCR).

- This technology has been rapidly replaced by neural networks that are able to process entire lines, instead of individual characters. In addition, methods of context analysis, Intelligent Character Recognition (ICR), are used to correct the actual OCR results.
- Intelligent Word Recognition (IWR) also falls under this category. This approach attempts to solve the problem of recognizing flowing handwriting, where individual characters cannot be clearly separated and recognized using by conventional OCR methods.

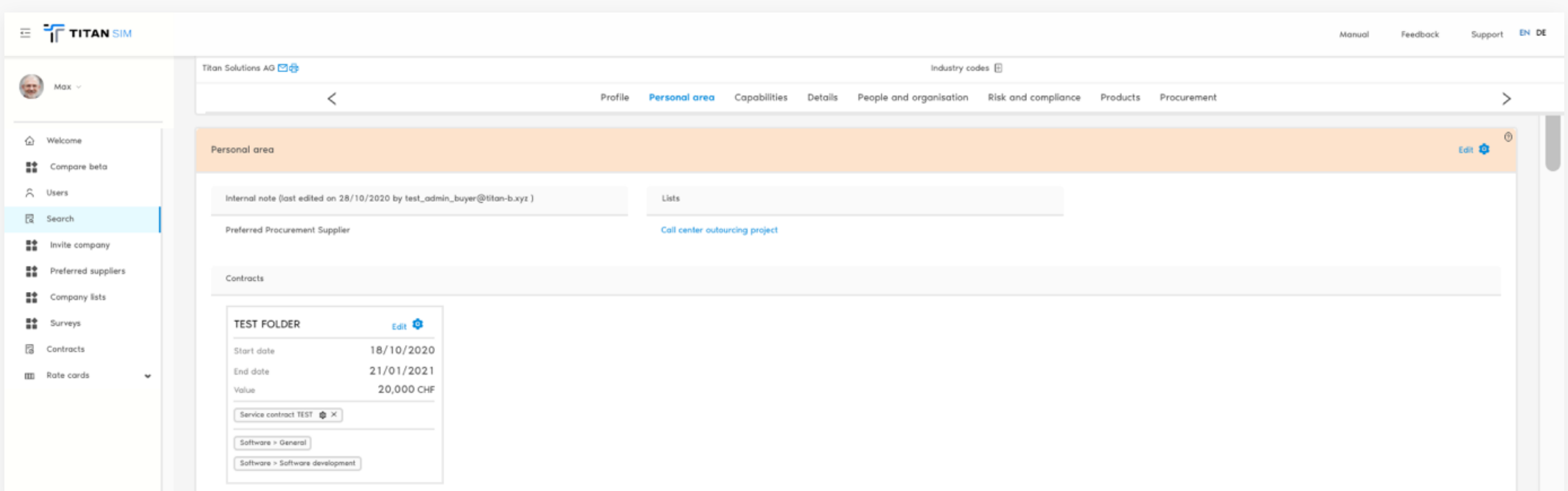

Data protection is key – Titan is a trusted data processor for our customers (buyers and sellers). We are compliant to all data protection requirements throughout one's customer journey. In the following paragraph, we will provide detailed explanations of the terminology, in order to provide you with a better understanding of the subject.



International standard ISO 15489 describes and standardizes principles and procedures of systematic record management. This standard provides a guide for the management of public and private organization records.

ISO 15489 standard defines record management as

"the efficient and systematic control and performance of the creation, receipt, retention, use, and disposal of records, including the processes for recording and preserving evidence and information about business processes and transactions in the form of records, to be performed as a management function."

With Titan SIM you will satisfy requirements for all main parts of the ISO standard, such as:

- Principle of record keeping (contract folder)
- Contracts and documents (also other documents)
- File number and file title (e.g. Contract number and purchase order number)
- Roles & Responsibilities (managed via Titan's Roles & Access management concept)



Completely paperless is not an option for registered limited or full liable companies. This is the case when a document could become important in a legal dispute. These situations include sureties, notarizations and court judgments that are extra-secured by embossing. The validity of such documents is only fulfilled if all watermarks, seals, rivets and cords with which they were provided when issued, are present.

Legal retention periods for contractual originals vary between countries, depending on the type of document. Enclosed are exemplary two countries and their regulations:



- **Germany**, between 2, 6 or 10 years by the HGB (German Commercial Code), the AO (German Tax Code), and for digital documents by the GoBD (Principles for the proper keeping and storage of books, records and documents in electronic form and for data access).
- **Switzerland**, between 10–20 years by the Art.5 GeBüV (Swiss Business Records Ordinance).

Digital documents must meet the same standards for secure storage as paper documents. Titan fulfills these requirements completely. In Germany, for example, these requirements are regulated by the GoBD. If paper documents are stored in lockable filing cabinets and cannot be accessed, the Resiscan guidelines of the German Federal Office for Information Security applies to digital documents. If documents are digitized in a compliance with the GoDB and Resiscan, paper originals are no longer required.

Therefor, a digital version that you can store in our long-term archive is perfectly sufficient.
